Board Policy No. 5016: STUDENT DETENTION POLICY

- A. A detention is the detaining of a student before or after regular classes or Saturday mornings.

- B. A student may be detained by a teacher or administrator as long as there is appropriate supervision under the following conditions:
 - 1. A student is given at least twenty-four (24) hours prior notice to the time of the detention. Whenever practicable the parent may be notified.

 - 2. A student shall not be detained for more than one hour per school day without parent or guardian permission.

 - 3. A student shall not be detained during breaks, passing time, or lunch times in lieu of detention except with parent or guardian permission and approval of the principal or designee.
