Board Policy No. 5032: **NOTIFICATION TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITIES OF
STUDENT MISCONDUCT**

- A. The Principal or other designee of the Superintendent shall, prior to the suspension or expulsion of any student, notify the appropriate law enforcement authorities of any acts of the student which may violate Penal Code section 245 covering assaults upon another person with a deadly weapon or a firearm.

- B. The Principal or other designee of the Superintendent shall notify the appropriate law enforcement authorities whenever a student brings a firearm or other weapon to school.

- C. The Principal or other designee of the Superintendent shall, within one schoolday after the suspension or expulsion of any student, notify the appropriate law enforcement authorities of any acts of the student which may violate Education Code section 48900 (b), (c), (d), or (n).

- D. The Principal or other designee of the Superintendent may, within one schoolday after the suspension or expulsion of any student notify the appropriate law enforcement authorities of any acts of the student which may violate Education Code section 48900 (a), (e), (f), (g), (h), (j), or (l).

- E. The Principal or other designee of the Superintendent shall notify the appropriate law enforcement authorities of any acts of a student that may involve the possession or sale of narcotics or of a controlled substance or of a violation of Penal Code sections 626.9 and 626.10 which are provisions of the California Gun-Free Zone Act.
