

**LAGUNA BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT**

Board Policy No. 6027:     PROHIBITION OF ALCOHOL AT ALL DISTRICT -  
SPONSORED STUDENT ACTIVITIES ON OR OFF DISTRICT  
PROPERTY

- A. The District is not responsible for and not liable for any non-District sponsored activity or event off District property which students may attend or be invited to attend and at which alcoholic beverages may be possessed, sold, furnished, or consumed on the premises on which the event or activity occurs.
  
- B. Pursuant to Board Policy 1001 (Use of School Facilities and Grounds), activities prohibited on District property or in any District facility include, but are not limited to, any activity which involves the possession, consumption and/or sale of alcoholic beverages or any substance restricted by law. This includes, but is not limited to, any activity at which students may be present.
  
- C. If a District-sponsored event or activity at which students will be present is held off District property, no alcoholic beverage shall be possessed, served, sold, furnished or consumed in any room or space which is dedicated to that event or activity. Should a violation of this provision be reported to the District, the District shall require such event or activity to take place in the future on District property.
  
- D. No District employee accompanying or supervising students at District-sponsored events at which District students are present shall bring, possess, purchase or consume alcoholic beverages at any time, whether on or off District property, from the commencement of the accompaniment, presence, or supervision of students to the completion of such activity or event. Violation of this provision may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination of employment. See also, District Board Policy 6019 (Field Trips and Excursions).
  
- E. Parents/guardians or other non-District personnel attending or accompanying students at any District-sponsored event or activity off District property are strongly encouraged not to bring to any such event or activity, or to possess, purchase or consume any alcoholic beverage at events or activities at which students will be present. Violation of this provision will result in the District requiring such activity in the future to be held on District property.
