Board Policy No. 6018: STANDARDS FOR DETERMINATION OF OBSOLESCENCE OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

- A. The following factors shall be considered for determining when instructional materials, either loaned to the District or in the District's possession and adopted by the Board are obsolete:
 - 1. The materials have not been used for instruction for a period of time.
 - 2. The materials are outdated.
 - 3. It is not anticipated by the Superintendent that the materials may be used in the future.
 - 4. The Superintendent recommends that the materials be determined to be obsolete.

- B. If the Superintendent recommends to the Board that specific instructional materials be determined as obsolete, the Superintendent also will recommend whether such materials are usable or unusable for educational purposes.

- C. If the Board determines that specific instructional material is obsolete and unusable for educational purposes, the Superintendent may dispose of such material in accordance with applicable law.
